Chair's overview of the past year:

This year has been challenging for the Research Ethics Committee. Owing to administrative difficulties during the first half of the year, the REC failed to meet deadlines for provision of opinions to researchers on more than one occasion. This was particularly distressing to a Committee which prides itself on the service it provides to applicants and which has previously had an excellent reputation for timely responses. I am pleased to report that since October 2013 we have had admirable Co-ordinator support from Anna Bannister, who has managed the backlog and ensured that we are now back on track. I am confident that we have now returned to the previous high quality of service.

As with many RECs, ensuring that all members meet the attendance requirements can be challenging, and this is particularly important when there are vacancies on the Committee. Unfortunately we had to cancel a meeting in October 2013 because of a lack of quorum. This year we have appointed two new members to the Committee, which will help to ensure there are always sufficient members in attendance. Jayne Hardicre, an R&D Practice Development & Support Lead, and Seonaid Beddows, a Research Governance and Administration Manager, are already proving to be valuable members. Thank you to all the members, and those co-opted from other RECs who have attended some meetings to ensure we are quorate, for their time and commitment preparing for meetings, providing input into the REC's deliberations, and making the job of the Chair such a pleasant one. I should like to express particular thanks to Anna Bannister for her help during the last few months.
