| Further information: | <p>On the Public facing strategic risk register there are a total of 6 risks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HRA 1, relating to the Research Systems Programme, has increased in score following the delay to the delivery partner procurement with a further procurement process required. - HRA 4, relating to the risk that trust in research, or in the HRA, is lost, has also increased in score as there have been a growing number of third party complaints received by the HRA. There is a growing expectation for the HRA to resolve issues, which may be beyond our remit from vocal and prominent communities on social media. - All other risks remain the same score as per the last risk register reviewed in August. <p>The Audit & Risk Committee reviewed these risks at its meeting on 10 November 2022.</p> |
