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#### Chair's overview of the past year:

Following the retirement of the previous Chair (Dr Drury) after many, many years of exemplary service to NRES, I took up the position of Chair in mid July 2011. I had previously been the Vice-Chair of the Committee and Steven Chandler was appointed as Vice-Chair in early October 2011. At present the committee operates without an Alternate Vice-Chair but we continue to encourage members to consider the position. Despite these major changes the Committee has functioned smoothly and members appear to have taken it all in their stride. The main issue, over my tenure this year, has been around PRSC in that a relatively small number of members have carried the burden of this work. Members recently agreed to adopt a system where the schedule of PRSC meetings for each year ahead is set and then distributed to all. Members can then book-in for Committees which suit their diaries. Members agreed that this would be fairer, as they would know how many PRSC there were in the year and how many each members should undertake to ensure equity, and also thought it would be easier for them to plan ahead. We are in the process of organising this and of course we must wait to see how it works but I am hopeful it will help avoid monthly calls for volunteers and balance the workload between members more evenly over the coming year.

I have enjoyed my period as Chair and the Committee so far and look forward to the future. The Committee works very well which is attributable not only to our member's commitment, energy and expertise but the excellent level of support we enjoy from our coordinator (Joan Brown) and all at the NE NRES REC centre.
