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Chair's overview of the past year:

Our Committee has reviewed a wide variety of studies during the past year. We have taken part in piloting "fast track" proportionate review in sub-committee of research projects where the applicant has not identified major ethical issues. This has been a new development for us, and we are becoming accustomed to a different "style" of review. We are, as always, very grateful to Charlotte Allen our Coordinator and to Christine Hobson our Assistant Coordinator for their cheerful and efficient support. Several applicants have commented appreciatively on the service which they have received from the Committee. Two members have resigned during the year but our current members bring their enthusiasm, skills and experience to our meetings. Their regular commitment in terms of meetings and training events attended and work undertaken between meetings is invaluable and appreciated. The number of studies reviewed this year is, as this Report suggests, reduced. However, it is still unclear whether or not this is a permanent trend, possibly due to more studies being submitted for proportionate review. We shall continue to do our best to act as a supportive "critical friend" to researchers who apply to us.
