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#### Chair's overview of the past year:

The year 2011-2012 has again seen many changes for NRES particularly in its operating procedures and formal structures. The Health research Authority (HRA) was launched as a special Health Authority in December 2011 with NRES at its core. This has resulted in changed ways of working at both national and local levels. Nationally, new positions of 'Research Ethics Officers' were advertised and recruited. At a local level, the coordinators' office in south Birmingham was closed in March 2012 with coordination for the Staffordshire REC moving to the northwest office in Manchester. Two temporary coordinators have worked with the Staffordshire REC since that time. It is anticipated that a permanent coordinator will be in post by September 2012. Currently there are fifteen committee members; six lay members and nine expert members. Attendance at the meetings is good and there is a sound and useful balance of skills and expertise evidenced. The Staffordshire REC meets on the second Wednesday of each month in Stone Staffordshire to review an average of five applications at each meeting. This is the maximum number of applications the committee feel comfortable reviewing if rigour and quality is to be maintained.

The Staffordshire committee continues to work closely with the network of West Midlands committees; the Chairs meet thrice annually to discuss issues pertinent to the work of the RECs both locally and nationally. However, since the closure of the west midlands coordinators' centre the committees are now no longer all serviced by the same centre and this has impacted the network in terms of the identity that had been developed as a west midlands sector.

The Staffordshire REC has a culture of excellence, good humour and good practice. Its members are highly professional and passionate about the work undertaken. I believe the committee is very well placed to develop further into the future.
