Chair's overview of the past year:

During this report year two long-standing members left the Committee. John Fowler – who I first met on the Guy's Hospital REC in the 1990s - completed his 10 years with London-Dulwich, and Krzysztof Rutkowski resigned to pursue further study. In addition, our Pharmacy expert, Chi Kai Tam, left after a few months to take up a senior post elsewhere. I would like to thank them all for their contribution and wish them well.

We have welcomed two new members, both with experience in clinical trials – Dr. Jiafeng Feng and Dr. Traiani Stari who is also a Statistician. Regular attendance by other stalwart members has ensured that there have been no inquorate meetings.

REC activity has remained stable with 56 new studies and 98 substantial amendments. Provisional opinion is still forms the majority of decisions (84%) but an Unfavourable opinion is rare. REC members continue to see the value in working with researchers to achieve a Favourable outcome. Targets are now being met and there has been a gratifying reduction in the average number of days taken to reach a final decision from 42 days (in 2014-15) to 29 days in this report year. No new applications exceeded 60 days.

Lastly, I would like to thank our REC Manager Stephanie Hill for her hard work during the year before she left to take up a new post. Stephanie had been with the REC since 2012 and provided excellent support to the old and new members. Michael Higgs joined us as REC Manager in January 2016 and impressed us all by his rapid acclimatisation to demands of the post.
