We have continued to review a wide selection of studies and we have particularly valued meeting applicants in person, where possible, and the subsequent discussion. The ethical issues frequently emerge and can be addressed in collaboration. The Chair now has a regular teaching commitment on the nursing research methods course at Derriford Hospital. Several members have moved on during the year due to other commitments - in every case their contribution to our work has been highly valued and has added to our shared "learning curve". Feedback suggests that this is mostly the case. We encounter some highly experienced researchers, Others are coming to us early in their research career.
