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Chair's overview of the past year:

I am delighted to have taken over from Francis in Feb this year as the Chair of Greater Manchester East Committee having previously sat on the committee as a member.

The committee comprises of an excellent mix of members with a good variety of backgrounds and skills that gel together to make a very effective, efficient, and as importantly supportive unit. Attendance is excellent with no meetings not being quorate in 2016/2017, David Asher heading the list with 9 meetings attended. Tireless support has been given to the committee by Rinat, and others in her sickness absence which has made our jobs significantly easier, and with the overview if Noel, the REC manager keeping things ship shape.

It has been a challenging year with the move to HRA pre approval which are starting to drift through now, and the trials of reviewing without papers via HARP which is working progress, the upgrade to HARP may make this easier. Chair appraisal should be welcomed with open arms to improve communication and consistency, and will be interesting.

Available training has been varied and interesting and all members have availed themselves of this facility, and we will encourage more members to avail themselves in the coming months.

The committee is working effectively with a 58% provisional opinion rate at meetings and nearly 40% favourable, whilst only 21% of provisional opinions are transferred to full committee. The average to final decision is 34 days which is excellent. 43 full ethical reviews have been undertaken in 2016/2017.

I would like to thanks the committee members and all the support staff for their excellent work and the results that we see encapsulated in the following report.
